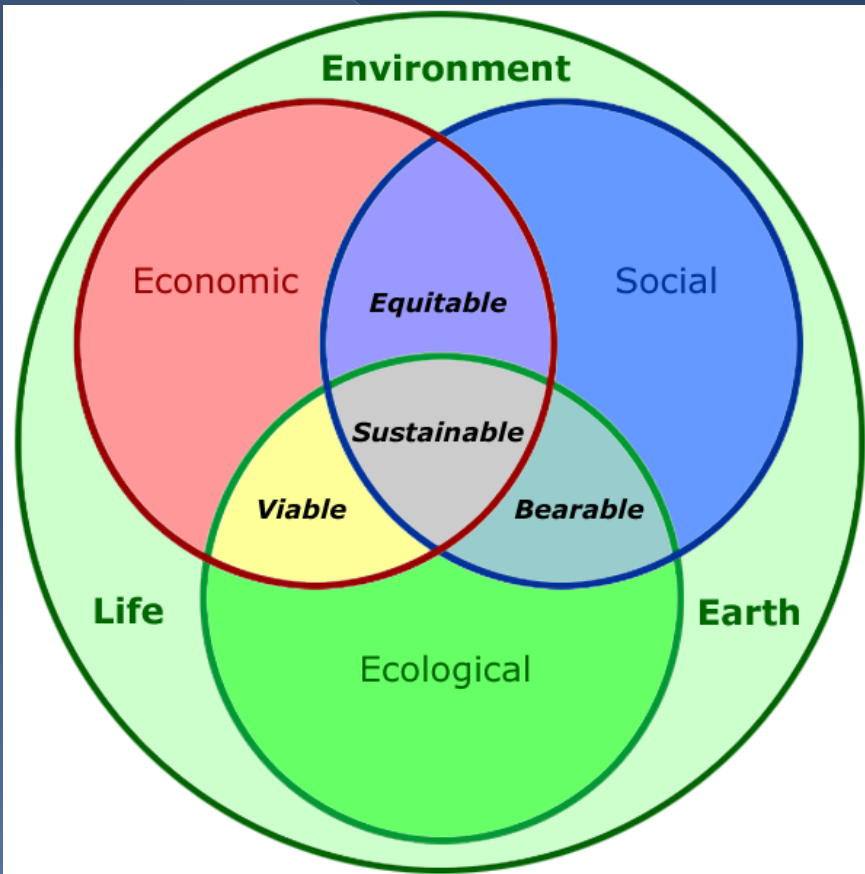


Waste it once...pay for it

In ecology, **sustainability** is the property of biological systems to remain diverse and productive indefinitely. In more general terms, sustainability is the endurance of systems and processes. 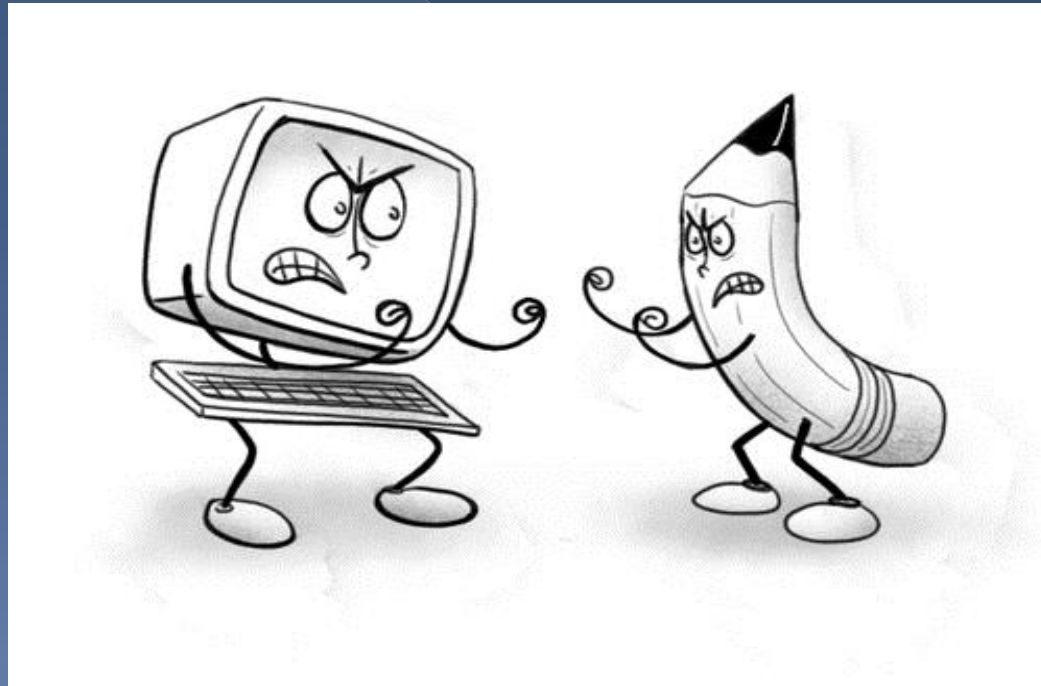
What can we do about it?
