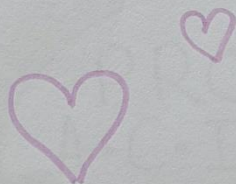


Projet Acide

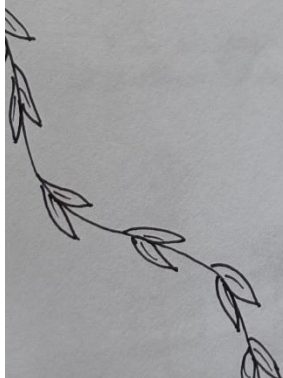



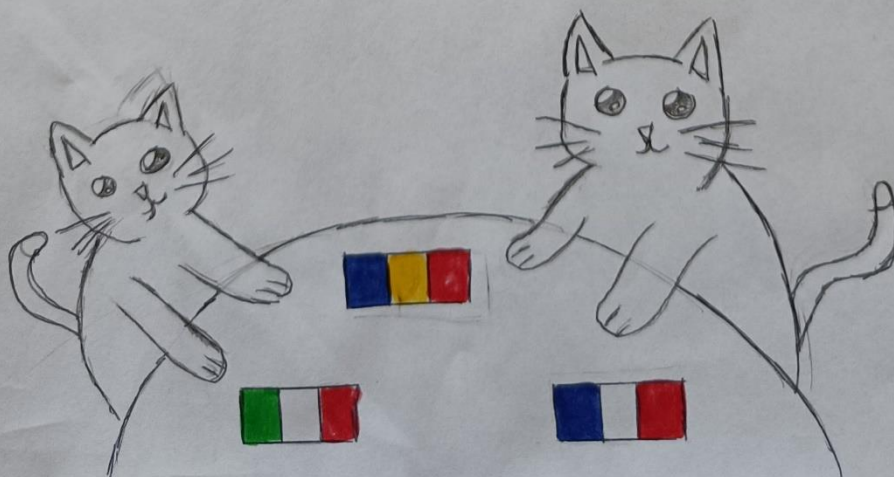

 - If I have to find a word for describe this week it's will be : "fantastic".

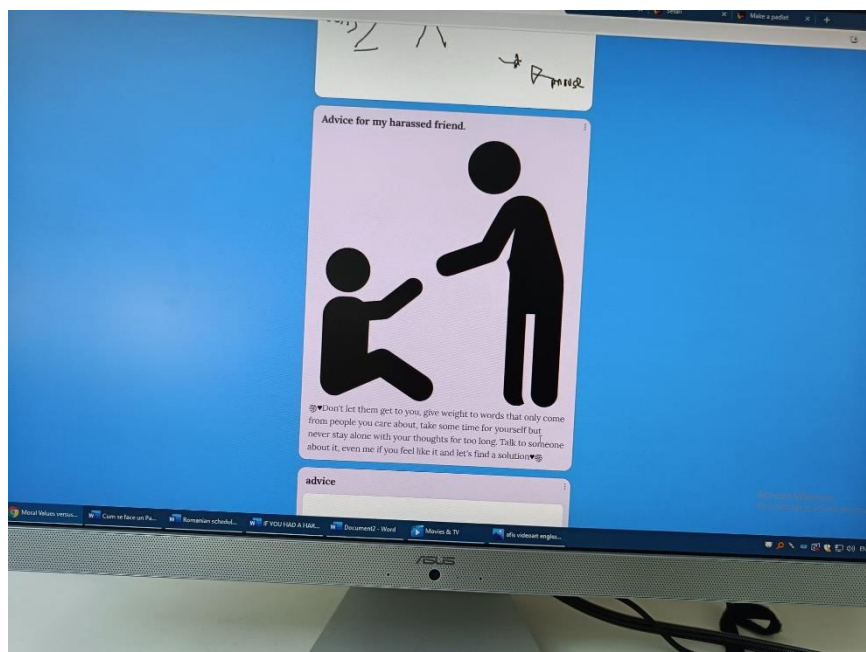

I really enjoyed my time in Suceava and I am sorry i will not meet my new Friends again



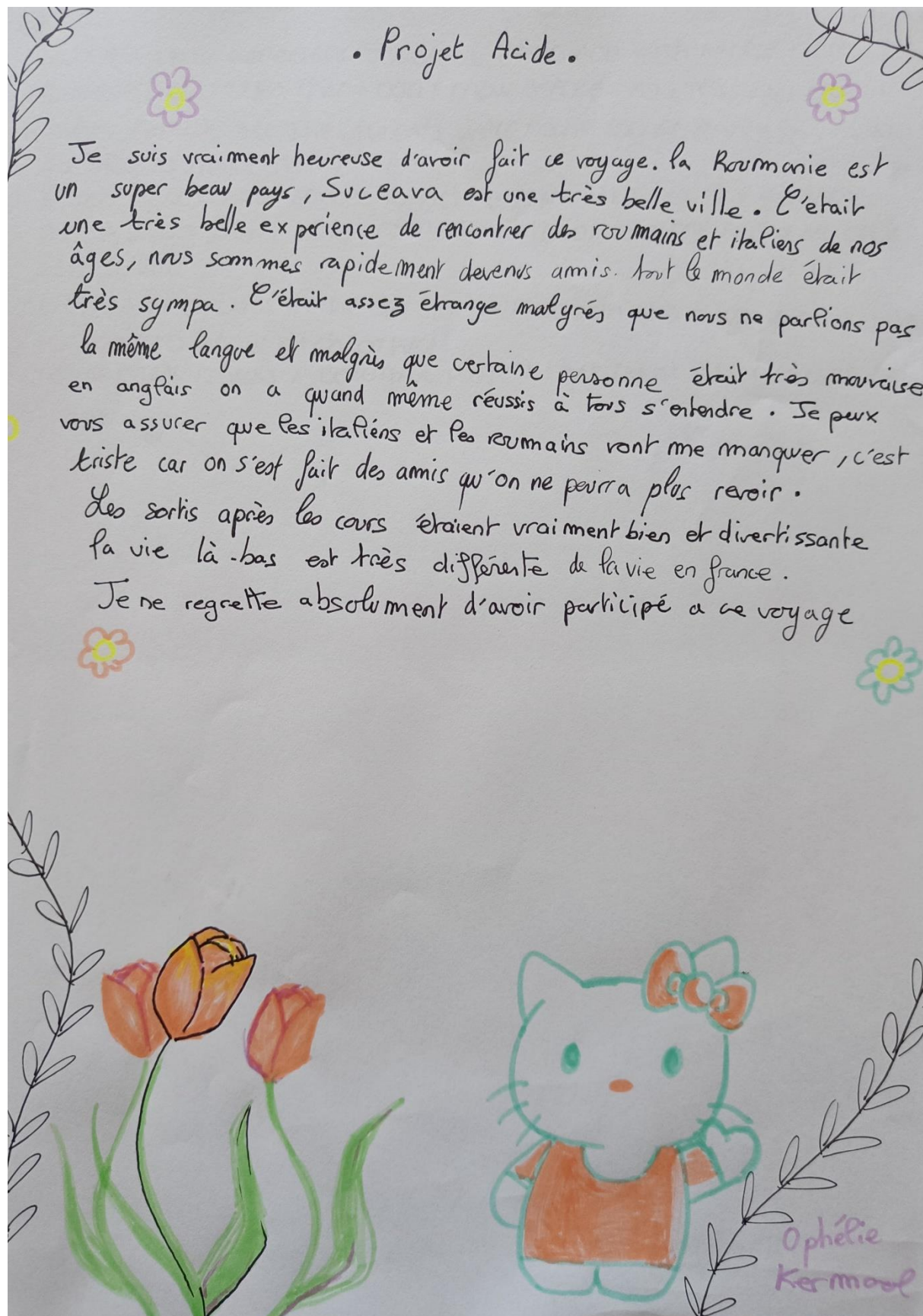

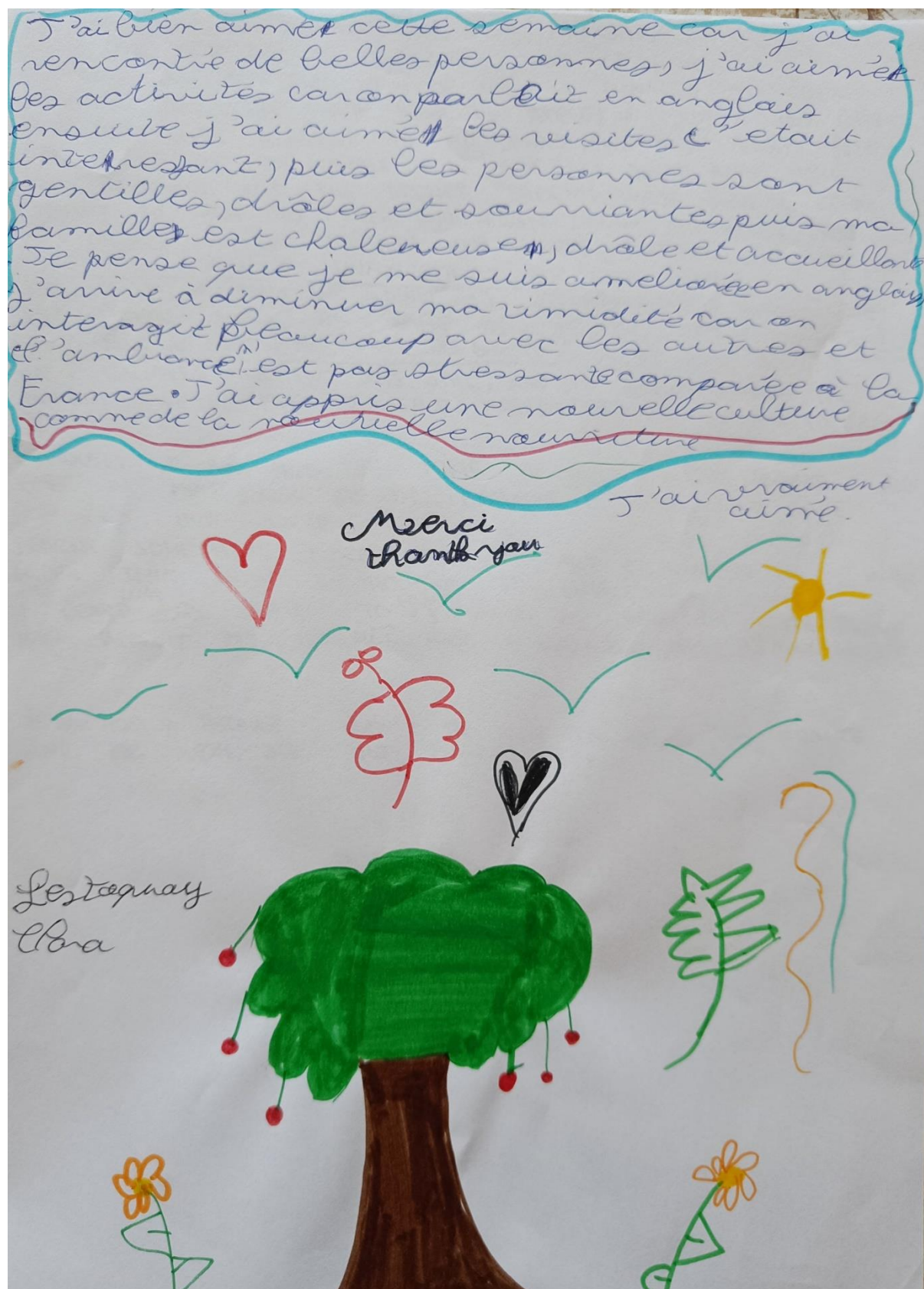
