CLIL project with pupils mobilities one month for International School

Our school is a public "Lycée Jean Bart" in the north of France, on the North Sea coast, in Dunkerque which is the third port in France. We would like to find a partner school practising CLIL (English) and ready to have one month mobilities in 2018-2019. In the beginning, it could be for 4 pupils on an exchange basis (October November in your country/ January February in France) with immersion in CLIL and EMILE (teaching of a subject in a foreign language). Our French pupils will need to have minimum 60% of their timetable in English or Spanish). Your pupils need to learn French. Of course, we absolutely need to have entire trust in the involved teachers, schools and families. We will evaluate the skills of all pupils before and after the trip.

Age of teenagers: 16 years old – 1st forms in French upper high school (lycée).
 The students are in pairs with a correspondent/family.

Born 2002 : 4 weeks in immersion.

The general selection criteria are based on the following skills:
 Motivation, Parental Support, Outgoing Personality, Autonomy, Academic Abilities.
 To find motivated, cheerful and hard-working teachers is our priority.
 We give a real importance to the label or spirit "international Collège".



It is not an Erasmus+ project but could be transformed into one in the future. (It may be a first step). So we do not have European funding. The families are asked to pay for transport to the partner country and back. For example, in France, we ask them for 200 euros, which cover the transport fares and some organisations expenses. A member of your staff needs to accompany the pupils to our school and stay 3/4 days at the beginning of the immersion to check everything and be sure that the agenda is ok, the pupils confident and see if they settle down. A convention will be signed between principals and the families are responsible for the host for the entire month.

We think it necessary and normal to have an evaluation with competences and marks at the end of the action. The selection is really important: mature and serious pupils, ready to live far from their family and responsible enough to follow lessons in France and work at home « their home class » lessons that you will send. We think it is essential the teachers and/or friends at school send by Internet copies of the lessons and homework so that the pupils taking part in the exchange do not completely miss the lessons and can catch up very quickly. It's our 3rd year of experience with 4 weeks immersion, and we can say that it was a great experience for the pupils, their parents and teachers. It is also an innovative action, very important for the school project and image.

Commitment of the school, the parents and / or the pupils:

- To take part in an individual mobility of the Erasmus+ pupils by accommodating and sending their child or student abroad, including the preparatory activities and follow-up.
- To attend the compulsory meetings arranged before the departure and on arrival.
- To submit the required application form and thus set up a file, basis for an oral discussion (parents and children) with the selection committee.
- To establish a training approval document (template available), fix a timetable in French and English (favoured) and different subjects in CLIL and give the number of hours carried out along with a learning agreement.
- The students taking part in the programme will be hosted in families and accept all the activities proposed. The sending lycée keeps contact by sending work by mail from their school.
- The students taking part in the programme must contribute to the final report and also give a public oral interview and presentation, which has to be submitted to the partner school (Video).
- To respect the practical methods of the exchange, concerning transport, insurance and training courses.
- During their stay abroad, the students taking part in the programme accept to live under the authority of the responsible adult appointed by the hosting school and of the hosting family;
- To respect the rules and procedures agreed upon between the schools, in the event of crisis.
- The international travel will be organized by the sending lycée and its cost will be the price of the plane ticket. The students will have to hand in to the school any supporting documents relevant to their travelling expenses (invoices, boarding cards, passage-tickets used).

Period of mobility between 4 and 6 weeks

Age of teenagers: 15-16 years old

2nd and 1st forms in French upper high school (lycée).
The students are in pairs with a correspondent.

15 years old: "second form in the French system"

French families and lycée host in January-February
Your school hosts in March- April.

16 years old: "first form in the French system"

French families and lycée host in January-February
Your school hosts in November- December

LYCEE JEAN BART



The High school is located in the centertown of Dunkerque, by the sea.
It was built on a 6-ha-long spot and is composed of several buildings, plus a boarding school, plus 2 gymnasiums.
It opens at 7 am and closes at 7 pm, on Wednesdays and Saturdays it opens at 7 am and closes at noon.



There are 648 girls and 524 boys who study from the sophomores to the seniors, they are about 15/16/17 or 18 years old. Moreover there are 81 girls and 236 boys among the students who are over 18 and study in preparatory classes.




In a nutshell, there are 1489 pupils/students at Jean Bart.

Besides Jean Bart hosts 2 disabled pupils and provides proper ways to move and to study. The success rate is tremendous = 98% for the 2015 results.



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HIGH SCHOOL FRAME WORK
