## Hi, I'm George:P

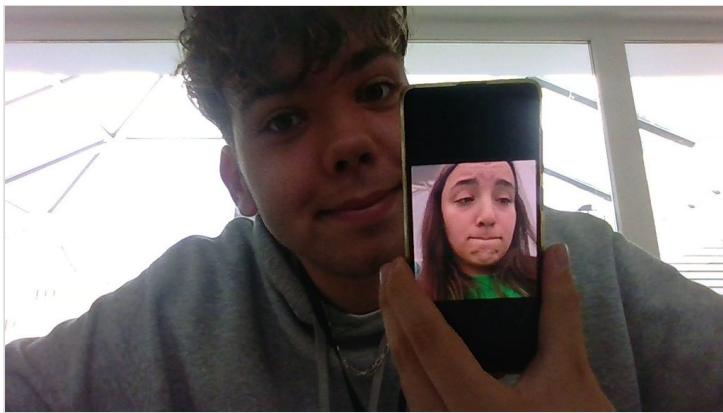
I've learnt that everyone can reach their dreams. They just want to be motivated through the school year, and the new school system helped a lot with this, because there were so many problems with this in the past.

## Hi, I'm Aga

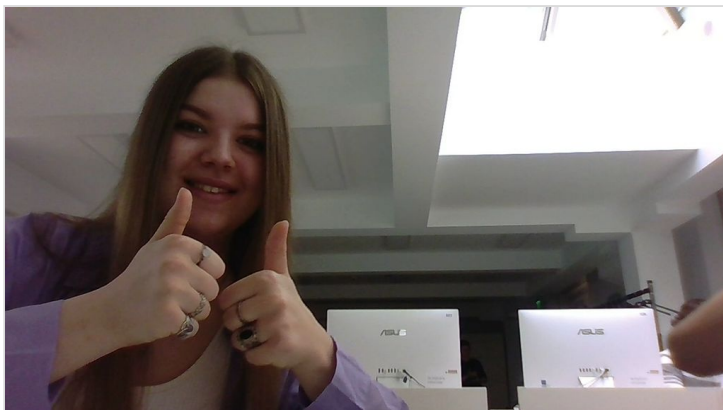

The fun facts were at every step and we experienced a wide range of things that made us laugh a lot 😊❤️

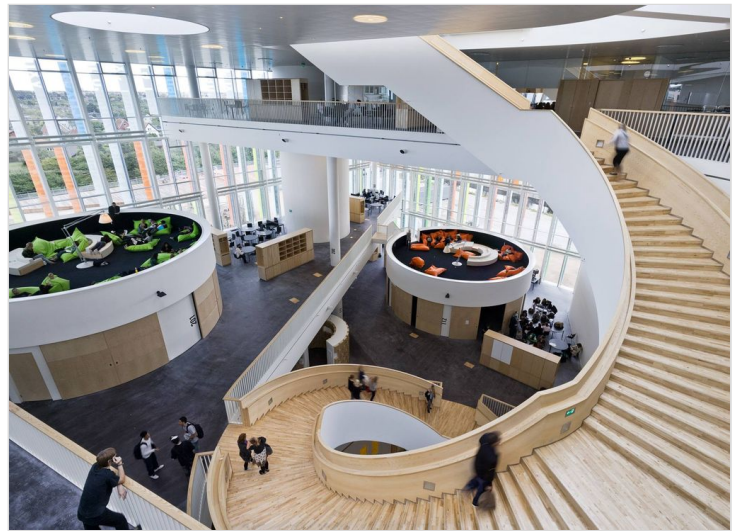
But at the end we still have some questions.....will we get the chance to experience all the amazing things? If not, will those who will experience them enjoy them? 🙌💖

I am so excited to spend more time with these people and to get to find out more about them.

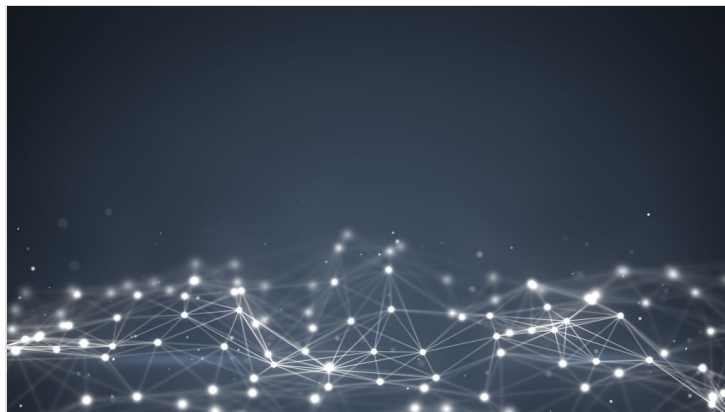


## Hi, I'm Raluca!

It was a fun activity, and I am glad that I had the opportunity to contribute.

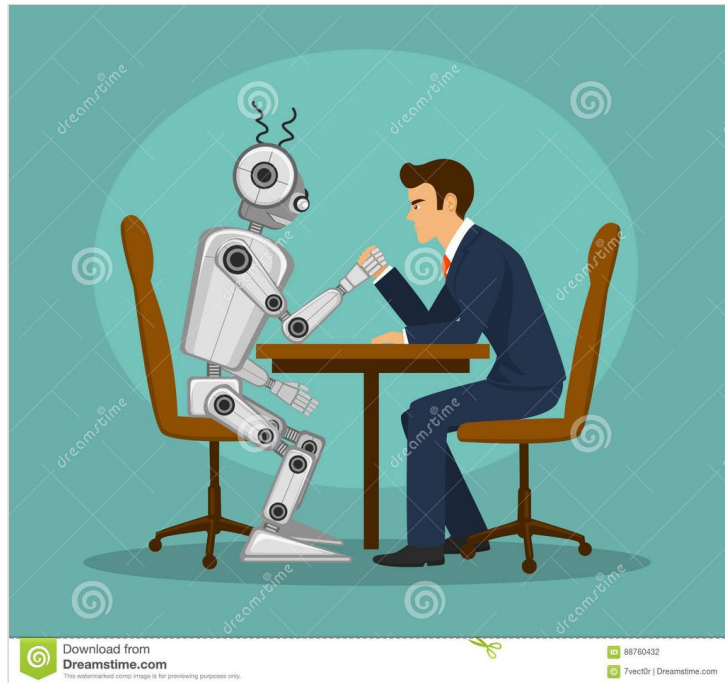


## Hallo, I am Maria and Luci

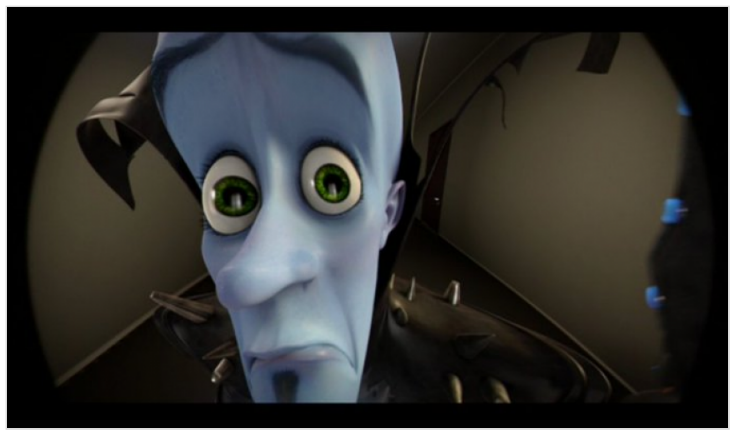


I am so glad that I got the chance to meet new and interesting people with different mindsets that made me question many things, but in a good way :)
